Eastern Pennsylvania and Delaware Section Mathematical Association of America

Revised in 1971, 1977, 1979, and 1980

ARTICLE I

Name and Purpose

- The name of this Section shall be the Eastern Pennsylvania and Delaware Section of the Mathematical Association of America, Inc.
- The purpose of the Eastern Pennsylvania and Delaware Section shall be to assist in the improvement of education in the mathematical sciences at the collegiate level by carrying out the purposes of the national organization within the territory defined below in Article II, Section I.

ARTICLE II

Membership

- The membership of the Eastern Pennsylvania and Delaware Section shall be as follows:
 - (a) Members of the Mathematical Association of America, Inc. residing in Delaware, ZIP codes from 19700 to 19900, and in that part of Pennsylvania with ZIP codes from 16900 to 19600.
 - (b) Members of the Mathematical Association of America, Inc. not being resident in the territory of this Section, who have become members of this Section in accordance with Article VI of the by-laws of the Mathematical Association of America, Inc.

ARTICLE III

Officers and Executive Committee

- 1. The President shall be elected annually and can serve at most two consecutive terms.
- The <u>Vice-President</u> shall be elected annually and can serve at most two <u>consecutive</u> terms.
- The Secretary-Treasurer shall be elected for a three-year term. The Secretary-Treasurer can serve at most two consecutive terms.
- 4. The Executive Committee shall consist of the <u>President</u> of the Section, who shall be chair of the Executive Committee, the <u>Vice-President</u>, the Secretary-Treasurer, the Sectional Governor, and six members-at-large. Each member-at-large shall be elected for a three-year term.
- 5. The members-at-large (of the Executive Committee) shall constitute the Program Committee.
- 6. Members of the Executive Committee shall be members of the Section.
- 7. The officers shall be nominated by a committee appointed by the <u>President</u>, but this shall not prevent other nominations being made by any member at the time of the annual election.
- 8. The <u>President</u> shall preside at all meetings of the Section and those of the Executive Committee. This individual shall have general charge and shall execute the affairs of the Section. The <u>President</u> shall appoint all committees unless otherwise directed by the members at a meeting and shall be an ex-officio member of all committees.
