Meet OPEN Math - MAA's Newest Program!

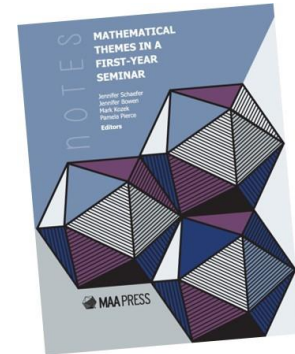
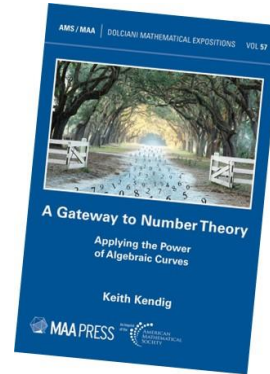
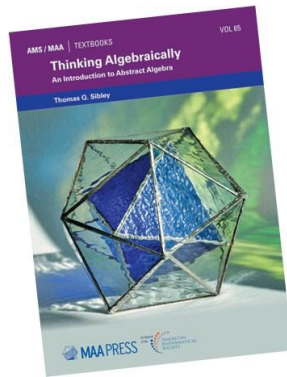
- Expands access to high-quality faculty professional development by eliminating the costs of travel

Count Me In

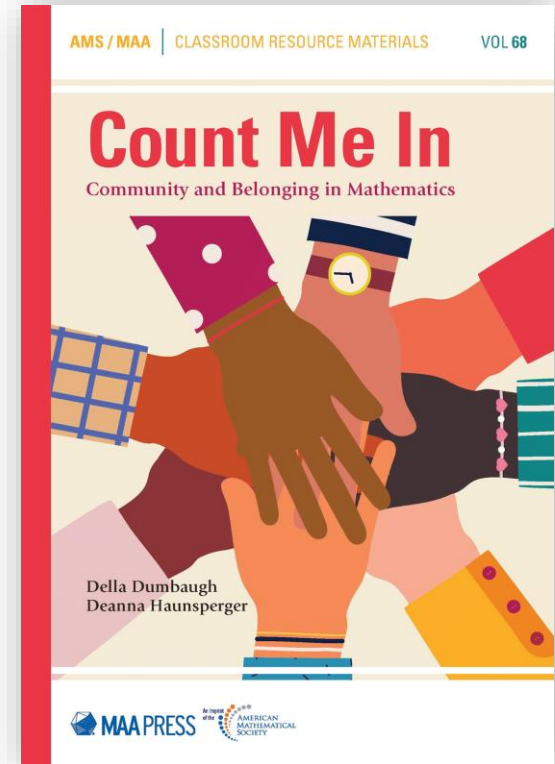
