Article I. Section 2

Completely re-written to conform with the recommendations of the national MAA.

Article III

This article was inserted to conform with the recommendations of the national MAA.

(Note: Since this article does not exist in the 2008 revision the article/section/paragraph numbers for the two documents do not match after Article II. Below, I will refer to the numbers in the 2019 revision.)

Article IV, Section 2

Modified to refer to the Section Representative instead of the Governor. Also it was not clear why the reference to Governors of other sections was in the 2008 revision so we have removed it.

Article IV, Section 4

Since we have two meetings every year we need to specify when the elections are to be held.

Article IV, Section 4, Paragraph a

Our current bylaws enforce a one year term, renewable once, for both the Chair and Vice Chair but in recent memory they have always served two consecutive terms. This change brings the bylaws into conformity with our actual practice for many years now.

Article IV, Section 4, Paragraph b

More precise language included at the recommendation of the Committee on Sections

Article IV, Section 5

Self explanatory.

Article IV, Section 6

Paragraph c was re-written on the recommendation of our current Secretary to more accurately reflect the function of the Secretary.

Article IV, Section 7

The list of examples of non-voting members of the Exec Committee was updated to remove any positions that no longer exist.

Article IV, Section 8

Self explanatory.

Article V, Section 1

The current bylaws clearly reflect the assumption that we only have one section meeting per year. Since we've been holding two per year for many years it seems reasonable to have our bylaws reflect this.

Article V, Sections 3 and 4

These were made more precise at the suggestion of the Committee on Sections.

Article VI, Sections 2 and 3

There is no substantial change in the meaning here. The intention is to be more precise in our language, as befits an organization of mathematicians.

Article VI, Section 4

No change of meaning. We just broke up a too long sentence.

Article VII, Section 1

"2/3" changed to "two thirds."

Article VII, Section 2

This section was made more precise at the recommendation of the Committee on Sections.
