Dear Professor Lindsay:

This is to notify you that the members of the Iowa Section of the Mathematical Association of America are to elect a Sectional Governor of the Association for a three year term beginning July 1, 1968 to succeed Professor D. W. Wall of the State University of Iowa.

The By-Laws of the Association and actions taken by the Board of Governors provide that:

- 1. At least two nominations for Sectional Governor shall be submitted to the members in each section by a nominating committee appointed by the Chairman of the section. The nominating committee should select, as candidates for office, members who have demonstrated interest in the Association. The committee should strive to select candidates who would be reasonably certain of attending meetings of the Board of Governors and would serve as an active representative of the section on the Board of Governors.
- 2. Governors are eligible for re-election only after an interim of three years.
- 3. Governors shall be elected by a mail vote to be conducted by the Associate Secretary of the Association.
- 4. The territory included in the Iowa Section is the state of Iowa.

Accordingly, I am asking you to appoint a nominating committee from the membership of your section and to instruct them to report to me their nominations for Governor as promptly as possible. This office will then proceed to send ballots to the membership of your section and will notify those concerned of the result of the election.
