The abstract should be in the form of a brief and concise statement of the main results or points of view of the paper, without demonstrations and with a minimum of formulae. It should not exceed 100 words and should be compressed, if possible, into a single paragraph. It should be written in the third person. The Vandermonde Convolutional Formula and other related binomial identities can be derived via elementary properties of polynomials.
