At the Business Meeting, in addition to the reports and election, we will need to reconsider the BY-LAWS for the Iowa Section which we adopted last year, but were not approved by the National Organization. Specifically, we need to consider the following alterations, with the changes proposed underscored:

Article III, Section 1. Insert <u>Past Chairman</u> between Chairman-Elect and Secretary-Treasurer

Article IV, Section 1. The Section shall hold an Annual Meeting in the Spring of each year.

Article IV, Section 2. The <u>Annual Meeting shall</u> be planned by the Chairman-Elect.

Article IV, Section 5. A Quorum shall consist of those members present at any <u>properly called</u> meeting of the section.

Article V, Section 1. There shall be no dues or registration fees assessed the members of the Section, unless the dues and/or fees are approved by the members at a properly called meeting.

Article VI, Section 2. The Chairman may appoint such other committees as required, or as the members present at any properly called meeting may direct.
