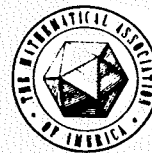

On January 1, 1976, the TWO-YEAR COLLEGE MATHEMATICS JOURNAL becomes an official publication of the MAA. With many MAA members selecting the TYCMJ instead of the AMERICAN MATHEMATICAL MONTHLY, the TYCMJ will begin in the May, 1976 issue, a new column dealing with two-year college news. One of the objectives of this new column is to carry MAA news items of interest to the readers of the TYCMJ.
