CALL for PAPERS and PARTICIPATION

The 1995 Iowa Mathematics Meetings will be held on April 21 and 22 on the University of Northern Iowa campus. These meetings are conducted jointly by the Iowa Section of the Mathematical Association of America and the Iowa Mathematics Association of Two-Year Colleges. The speakers will be Professor Barbara Faires from Westminster College and Professor Izaak Wirszup from The University of Chicago. Student papers will be presented Friday afternoon; faculty papers Saturday afternoon. In addition, there will be a social gathering Friday evening, a book exhibit Friday afternoon and Saturday morning, and activities for students. The business meeting will take place Saturday morning.

This letter is our call to you to submit abstracts of papers for presentation at the meeting. Papers in all areas are welcome. We particularly encourage papers on the teaching of mathematics and the use of technology in courses. We have two rooms that are equipped with ceiling mounted RGB projectors which provide a six foot image. Each projector is connected to a Gateway 386 which has access to the internet (lynx, but not mosaic) and a VCR. One room also has a projector connected to a MacIntosh. We may be able to satisfy special requests such as a videodisc player or mosaic, etc. **Please make requests early.** Suggestion for special sessions, panel discussion, etc., are also solicited.
