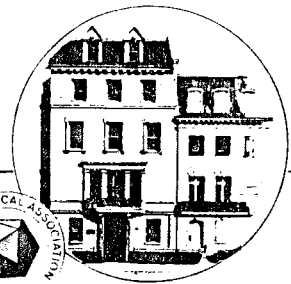

Dear Professor Fink:

About two years ago the Committee on the Exchange of Information on Mathematics (CEIM) established a subcommittee to provide assistance and encouragement to the various Sections of the MAA in developing and expanding local publicity efforts.
