

Dear Professor Kosier:

I am writing to remind you that the members of the Iowa Section of the Mathematical Association of America are to elect a Section Governor of the Association for a three-year term beginning July 1, 1980 to succeed Professor James Cornette of Iowa State University at Ames.

The Bylaws of the Association and actions taken by the Board of Governors provide that:

- 1. At least two nominations for Sectional Governor shall be submitted to the members in each Section by a nominating commuttee appointed by the Chairman of the Section. The nominating committee should select, as candidates for office, members who have demonstrated interest in the Association. The committee should strive select candidates who would be reasonably certain of attending meetings of the Board of Governors and would serve as an active representative of the Section on the Board of Governors.
 - 2. Governors are eligible for re-election only after an interim of three years.
- 3. Governors shall be elected by a mail vote to be conducted by the Executive Director of the Association.
 - 4. The territory included in the Iowa Section is Iowa (50000-52899).

Accordingly I am asking you to appoint a nominating committee from the membership in your Section and to instruct them to report to me their nominations for Governor by January 20 at the latest. This office will then proceed to send ballots to the membership of your Section and will notify those concerned of the result of the Election. We would appreciate it if you would send us the names of your Section's nominating committee by December 20 at the latest.
