Dear Professor Fink:

I have just recently learned that the annual meeting of the Iowa Section of the MAA is being held at the same time as the annual meeting (in St. Louis) of the National Council of Teachers of Mathematics. Since many mathematics educators are members and supporters of both organizations the conflict in meeting dates is unfortunate. It's obviously too late to change the meeting time this year, but I did want to alert you to the problem so that, hopefully, it might be avoided in succeeding years.

The conflicting meeting dates raises the general issue of communication between the Iowa Section of the MAA and the Iowa Council of Teachers of Mathematics. To my knowledge there has been almost no contact between the two organizations in the 15 years I've been in Iowa. Since the two groups share many common interests and common goals, it seems as if there would be merit in establishing a formal means of ensuring communication between them. This certainly isn't a novel idea. At the national level, the MAA, AMS, ASA and NCTM share many committee responsibilities. And, of course, the Conference Board of the Mathematical Sciences serves (although not always well) to provide a vehicle for exchange of information and ideas among these and other groups. I'm merely trying to promote a similar kind of sharing at the State level.

I'm sending a copy of this letter to Dr. Bonnie Litwiller (UNI Mathematics Department) who is currently President of the Iowa Council of Teachers of Mathematics) in the hope that she or her successor will initiate a discussion with you about mutual concerns.

You have my best wishes for a successful April meeting.
