

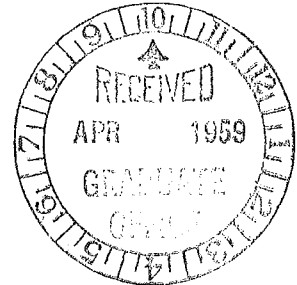

Dear Earle:

I believe most of the details for our meeting at Mount Pleasant have been taken care of. I have appointed Fred Robertson (Chairman, Ames) Robert V. Hogg, (Iowa City) and John Arrison (Mt. Pleasant) to serve on the nominating committee to select chairman, vice-chairman, and sec-treasurer for next year. I made a trip to Mt. Pleasant last Monday to see if arrangements there were satisfactory and I believe they are. I shall have to bring along a projector and a screen.

I offered Professor Day \$100 to give the morning address. I really don't know how to proceed with the formal payment of this. Do I authorize you as the secretary-treasurer to send him a check? If so, consider this as authorization. Perhaps we could give it to him at Mt. Pleasant.

I have appointed Malcolm Smiley to serve as chairman on a committee of three to nominate a new governor from the Iowa Section. I have written to B. Vinograde (Ames) and J. O. Chellevoid (Wartburg) and asked them to serve as the other members. I have not heard from them yet but I expect to in the near future, and it should be only a short time before the nomination for governor is completed.

There is one correction to our program at Mt. Pleasant. Professor Nolte of Ames added a paper after I sent the program to Lindahl and his name is included on the general program that the Iowa Academy sent out.
