Tower Park

About 3 or 4 miles from campus in Fort Thomas, Kentucky, is the site of Fort Thomas' original military installation. It is now <u>Tower Park</u>, and it has playground equipment as well as a set of extensive hiking trails (some with Ohio River overlooks).

Newport on the Levee

About 6 miles from NKU is an entertainment district in Newport, Kentucky, called <u>Newport on the Levee</u>. It is near the Fairfield Inn & Suites. It includes the Newport Aquarium, an indoor miniature golf course, and several eating and drinking establishments.

Purple People Bridge

About 6 miles from campus is a pedestrian bridge that crosses the Ohio River. On the Kentucky side of the bridge is <u>Newport on the Levee</u>. On the Ohio side is <u>Sawyer Point Park</u> and the Serpentine Wall.

The Banks
