Meeting called to order at 1:30pm

- I. Approval of the Minutes of October 14, 2023 (Action Item)

- III. Report of the Treasurer Phillip Poplin
 - a. Presented spring meeting data. Paid out a little more than brought in. Higher speaker expenses than usual, and higher supply cost than normal. Student achievement fund paid out \$433.33. Section Next fund contribution of \$4500 finally showed up, correct mistake with national office. Commit fund is at about \$428. Account for speakers. Money will probably be out in 2 or 3 more meetings. Showed combined accounts balance over time holding fairly steady between \$5k to \$10k. More schools will start charging for facilities. In fall cost \$1k, supposed to be \$4k, able to get help. In spring, \$1k for meeting facilities charge. Showed separate account balances graph. Attendance for fall 2024: 49 total early, 7 late for total of 56. 10 section NExT. 1 undergrad and 11 graduate students. Historic registrations by semester graph were shown. Low number of student registrations this semester is not unusual. Questions: Should we raise registration fee by \$5ish? (A: Exec committee will discuss and decide on this).

 - i. Exec committee motioned to move \$4500 to a separate fund. Passes unanimously
