We are pleased to announce that the Missouri Collegiate Mathematics Contest (MCMC) will return to a face-to-face format for the spring of 2022.

The contest is open to teams of one-to-three students from colleges in Missouri. Each school can register up to two official teams and any number of unofficial teams. A team of one student is allowed only if that is the only team from that school.

It will consist of one part on Thursday evening of the section meeting from 7:30 – 10:00 p.m. and one part on Friday morning from 8:30 – 11:00 a.m. Each part will consist of five questions.
