## Putnam Plaques

On 8 February 2016 Chair Amy Schachle sent the following to the Executive Committee.

Hello All,

Lisa is proposing that we consolidate the two traveling Putnam plaques into one plaque. In the process, she also will make some corrections and bring uniformity to the way the names are listed on the plaques. We can use size 16" x 20" which would fit 75 plates in the same size as the current ones and also a header plate (the current plaques are 10" x 14" each). Then a \*single\* plaque would travel throughout the section. The cost of the new plaque will be in the \$230 range (with some variability). The proposal is to approve up to \$250 to have the new plaque made.

She also proposes that we put a page on the section web site to list the Putnam winners down through time, so that if at some point we need to take a column of old plates off of the plaque to make room for new ones, that the information on these old winners will be preserved.
