History of Mathematics Student Poster Contest

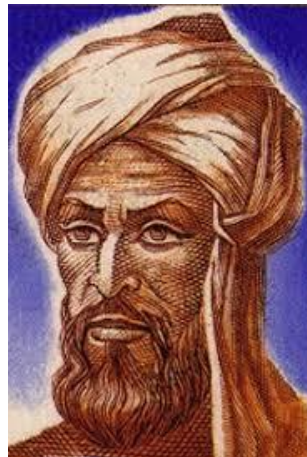
Rocky Mountain Section Annual Meeting

Contest Guidelines

- Topics can be drawn from any field of mathematics.
- Posters can address a single person or topic, or be an historical survey of a culture or topic.
- Posters must include a full reference list and an acknowledgement of any outside help.
- Posters should not draw too heavily from web sources.
- Posters must be the sole production of students who are enrolled as undergraduates at a school that lies within the geographic area of the Rocky Mountain Section.
- At least one author of each poster must register for and attend the Section Meeting in Denver. For meeting registration details, visit <http://sections.maa.org/rockymt/>.
- A **poster abstract** (up to 250 words) must be **submitted on or before March 27**. Please also include the poster title, the names and school affiliations of its author(s) and the name and e-mail address of the poster's faculty sponsor.
