The Executive Committee of the Mathematical Association of America-Michigan Section is continuing the policy of notifying all current Michigan MAA members about the activities of the Michigan Section and notifying them that Section dues for 1985-1986 are payable at this time. Membership in MAA entitles you to become a member of the Michigan Section. However, Section membership requires additional dues of \$5.

Since we operate on a very stringent budget, the collection of Section dues from individual members is critical. Activities of the Michigan Section include the following:

1. Michigan Mathematics Prize Competition (MMPC)
2. High School visiting lecturer program
3. Annual spring meeting (no registration fees for dues-paying members)
4. Grading day for MMPC (#1)
5. Student awards for student paper presenters at the Annual Spring meeting and Putnam winners
6. Newsletter
7. Summer conference
8. Involvement with educationally-related state legislative issues

Coordination of these activities, consideration of other activities, representation at national meetings and Executive Committee meeting expenses are funded through Section dues. As you can see, the relatively modest amount of \$5 will help maintain the high level of activity the Michigan Section has been known for over the past years.


