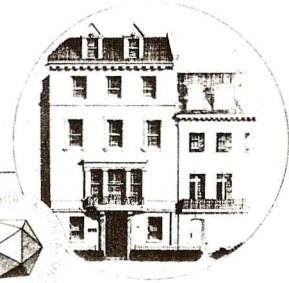

Dear Professor Bronn:


