

Executive Committee Minutes
Rocky Mountain Section, MAA
April 22, 1989

The minutes from 1988 were read and approved. The Financial Report was approved.

Chair-Elect Duane Porter will contact Colorado College about hosting a meeting in 1991.

Treasurer Bill Emerson indicated that checks will be mailed from Denver to cover the cost of the meeting. Expenses for the speaker will be covered by the section from the registration fees.

About 25% of the people preregistered. There were about 85-90 people in attendance and 75 people at the banquet.

Four student papers were given. Each will receive a one-year membership.

Duane moved that the expenses of Metropolitan State College and Ft. Lewis College in support of the newsletter be covered by the section. The motion passed.

Duane noted that the second weekend in April in 1990 is Easter and the third weekend is the NCTM meeting in Salt Lake City. Duane will call for a straw vote at the Business Meeting between the first and last weekend of April for next year's meeting.

Bill noted that the Alliance for Science is promoting cooperation between education and industry in science and mathematics.

John Gill will present a governor's report at the Business meeting. He also reported that national dues will increase next year and that there will be a two-tiered dues structure depending on the income of the member. The MAA will support the standards of the NCTM, but not the specific recommendations.

Short Courses: Ft. Lewis will have one but will not ask the MAA to sponsor it. The executive committee should approve any short course that is sponsored by the section. The committee discussed preparing a policy about applying for support and sponsorship of short courses
