PIC Math is accepting applications from faculty interested in participating in PIC Math during the 2023-2024 academic year. PIC Math prepares students for industrial careers.

Applications are due **March 31**. Learn more at maa.org/pic-math

What does PIC Math entail?

- A spring 2024 semester course taught at the faculty member's own institution. During the course, student teams work on a real-world problem from business, industry and government (BIG), and they submit a written report and a video of their solution at the end of the semester. Faculty receive a \$3000 stipend.
- A four-day virtual faculty training workshop during the week of July 10-14, 2023. The workshop will provide faculty with information and training to teach the spring 2024 PIC Math course and prepare students for industrial careers.
- PIC Math student recognition session at the SIAM conference in Spokane, WA during July 8-12, 2024. Student teams receive up to \$2,000 in travel support.
