Business Minutes Wisconsin Section of the MAA April 6, 2013 UW-Marshfield/Wood County

The minutes of the April 14, 2012 meeting were approved.

Jonathan Kane presented the Treasurer Report. The report was approved after a discussion about the \$50 account closing fee and about the use of PayPal for meeting preregistration.

It was recommended that the banquet cost be kept low and compensate for this by raising the meeting registration fee. Many attendees get reimbursement for meeting registrations but not for the banquet.

Andy Matchett presented the Governor's report stating that the MAA will end operating on a deficit by increasing revenue through increasing participation in AMC contests and changing the dues structure by reducing the over 100 membership categories to only 6.

Thomas Drucker from UW-Whitewater was nominated for Chair-Elect. A motion to close nominations and elect Thomas Drucker unanimously was approved.

The 2014 Spring Meeting will be held at UW-Whitewater either the first or last weekend of April with preference being voiced for the first weekend of April. The final dates will be announce by the middle of April, 2013. Meeting locations for the 2015 meeting were solicited with the idea that it is time to hold the meeting in western Wisconsin. Ripon College would like to host a meeting in the near future.

Walter Stromquist and Bob Devaney spoke as representatives the MAA. Walter suggested that the MAA magazines are always looking for authors and reviews. Bob reminded the group that 2015 is the Centennial of the MAA which will be celebrated at MathFest 2015 in Washington, DC.
